The ICF/Monsignor Peter Mimmagh Scholarship is an annual award made by the Italian Catholic Federation Branch 246 of the St. Vincent de Paul Church.

Who is eligible?

- Children, grandchildren and wards of legal guardians of all St. Vincent de Paul parishioners (whether or not they are members of the ICF) who are attending St. Vincent de Paul School.
- Children, grandchildren and wards of legal guardians of good standing members of ICF Branch 246 who may be attending other primary or secondary Catholic schools.

How to apply?

- Applications are available in the school office, the parish office or on line at the school web site www.svscatholic.org beginning April 1st
- Complete the application and return it to the parish office by **June 1st**.

Who should I contact if I have Questions?

What are the award criteria?

- The Scholarship Committee considers academics, community service, religious and spiritual achievements.

Who selects the award recipient(s)?

- The scholarship committee of the ICF nominated by the ICF Board of Directors, Branch 246.

When will the award recipient(s) be notified?

- The winner(s) will be notified by June 15th. They and their family will be invited to the regular dinner meeting of the ICF in September to receive their award.

This scholarship is given to honor the memory of Msgr. Mimmagh, former pastor of St. Vincent de Paul Church from 1968 to 1992, whose dedication, love, gentleness, and concern for all will live forever in the hearts of the parishioners.
